3. Case-Based Study: Poverty as a Persistent Economic and Social Challenge

Despite decades of planned economic development, poverty continues to remain one of the most pressing challenges in India. Poverty is not merely the absence of income; it is a condition characterised by hunger, malnutrition, lack of access to education and healthcare, unemployment, social exclusion, and insecurity. For millions of people, poverty determines not only their living conditions but also their life opportunities.

In rural areas, poverty is often linked to landlessness, low agricultural productivity, dependence on monsoon rainfall, and seasonal unemployment. Small and marginal farmers frequently borrow money from informal sources to meet basic needs or invest in farming. Crop failure, illness, or natural disasters can easily push such households deeper into poverty. Agricultural labourers and migrant workers face uncertain employment and low wages, making it difficult to escape the cycle of deprivation.

Urban poverty presents a different but equally complex picture. Large numbers of people migrate to cities in search of better livelihoods, only to find employment in the informal sector as construction workers, street vendors, domestic helpers, or factory labourers. These workers often live in overcrowded slums with inadequate sanitation, unsafe drinking water, and limited access to public services. The absence of job security and social protection makes urban poor highly vulnerable to economic shocks such as inflation, job loss, or health emergencies.

Poverty in India is also closely connected to social factors such as caste, gender, and regional disparities. Historically marginalised communities like Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes experience higher levels of poverty due to discrimination, limited access to resources, and low educational attainment. Women, particularly in poor households, face unequal access to nutrition, healthcare, and education, further reinforcing intergenerational poverty.

Recognising the multi-dimensional nature of poverty, the government has introduced various poverty alleviation programmes. These include employment generation schemes, subsidised food distribution, housing programmes, and initiatives to promote education and skill development. While these programmes have helped reduce poverty levels over time, challenges such as improper implementation, lack of awareness, and exclusion of deserving beneficiaries persist.

Thus, poverty remains not only an economic problem but a social and structural challenge that requires long-term, inclusive, and sustainable solutions.

4. Case-Based Study: Food Security in India

India produces a large quantity of food grains every year, yet millions of people still face hunger and malnutrition. Ensuring that all citizens have access to sufficient, safe, and nutritious food at all times is referred to as food security. Achieving this goal remains a significant challenge due to a combination of social, economic, and administrative factors.

Ramesh, a farmer from a small village in Uttar Pradesh, grows wheat and rice on his modest land. While his own family has enough to eat, many landless labourers in his village struggle to secure adequate food. During the lean agricultural season, these workers depend on daily wages to buy food from local markets. When employment is uncertain, their food intake becomes irregular, leading to malnutrition, especially among children and women. In urban areas, migrant workers face a similar problem; they live in congested slums with limited access to affordable, quality food.

The Indian government has recognised the need for ensuring food security through policies such as the Public Distribution System (PDS), which provides subsidised grains to poor families, and welfare programmes like Mid-Day Meal Scheme, Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS), and the National Food Security Act (NFSA) of 2013. These programmes aim to guarantee minimum food requirements for vulnerable groups. However, their implementation faces challenges. Leakage of grains, corruption, inaccurate

targeting of beneficiaries, and poor infrastructure often prevent food from reaching the intended people.

In addition, food security is affected by environmental and economic factors. Droughts, floods, and soil degradation reduce crop yields, while inflation increases the price of essential food items, making it unaffordable for the poor. Unequal distribution of resources such as land and water also limits production and access. In this context, sustainable agricultural practices, modern storage facilities, and efficient supply chains become essential components of food security.

Furthermore, food security is not only about calories but also nutrition. Many people may get enough food to eat but still suffer from hidden hunger, a deficiency of essential vitamins and minerals. Policies must therefore address both quantity and quality of food. Civil society initiatives, community kitchens, and nutrition awareness programmes complement government efforts to ensure that food security translates into actual health benefits.

India's experience demonstrates that food security is a multi-dimensional challenge. It involves production, distribution, affordability, nutrition, and sustainability. Tackling it requires coordinated efforts from governments, farmers, communities, and individuals, along with strong monitoring and accountability mechanisms to ensure that policies reach the most vulnerable.
